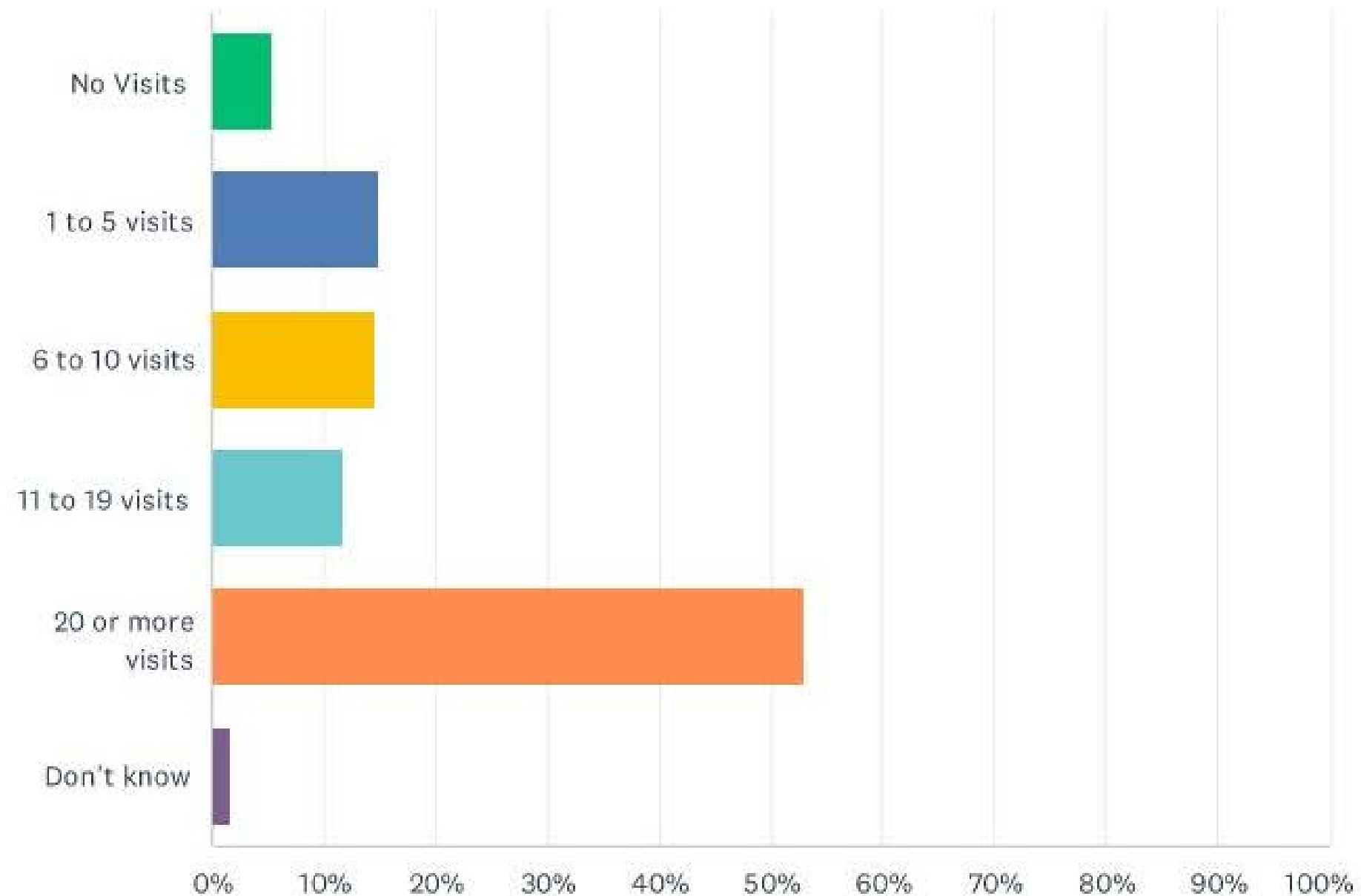

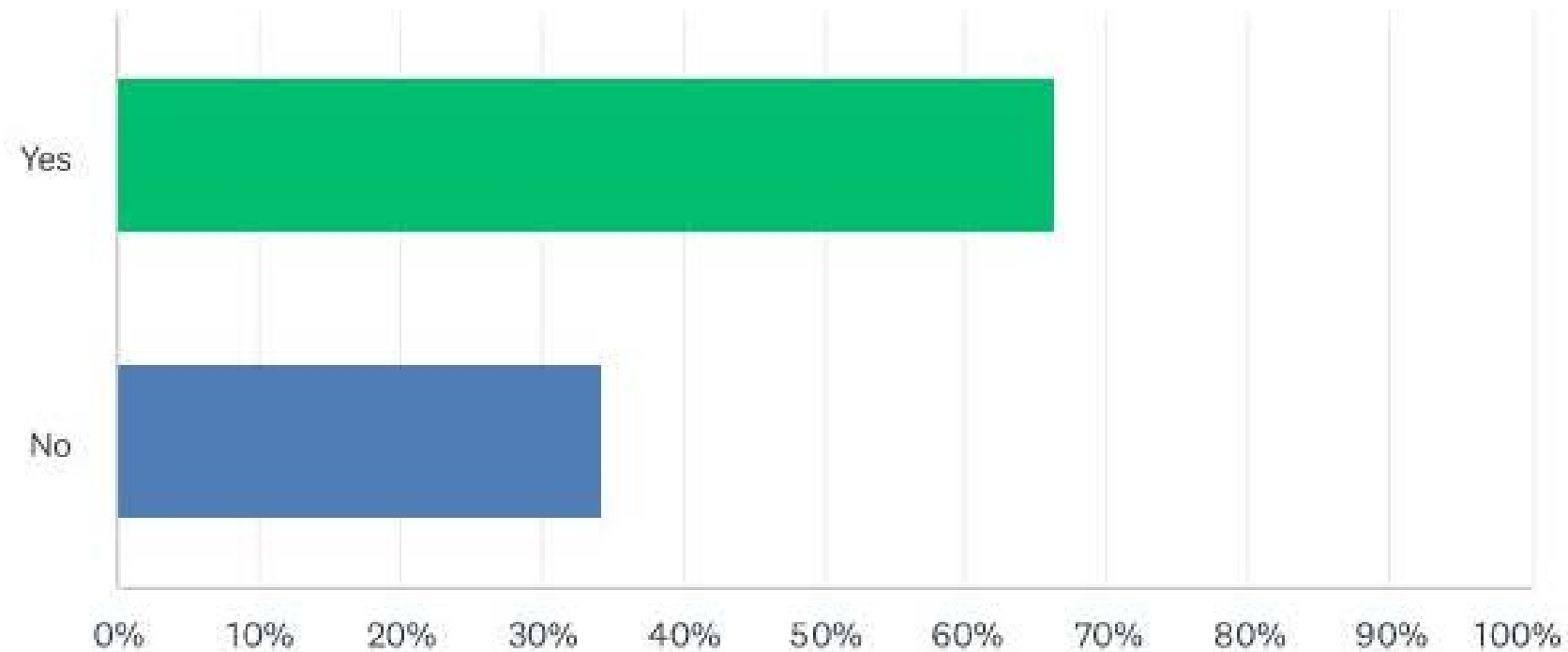
Q3 Approximately how often did you or members of your household visit any RAPRD facilities or parks over the past 24 months?

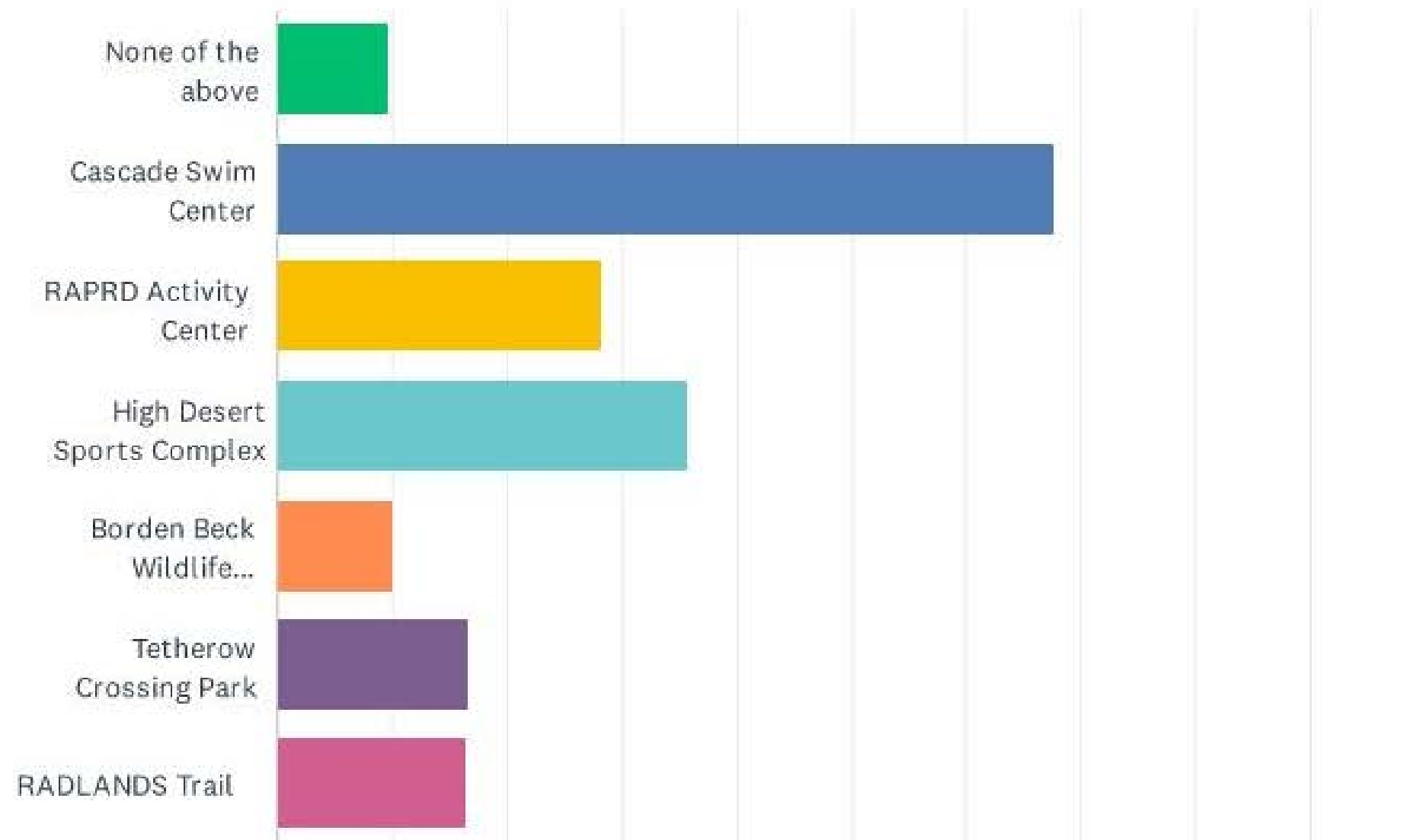
Q5 Have you or other members of your household participated in any recreation, sports or fitness/wellness programs offered by RAPRD during the past 24 months?

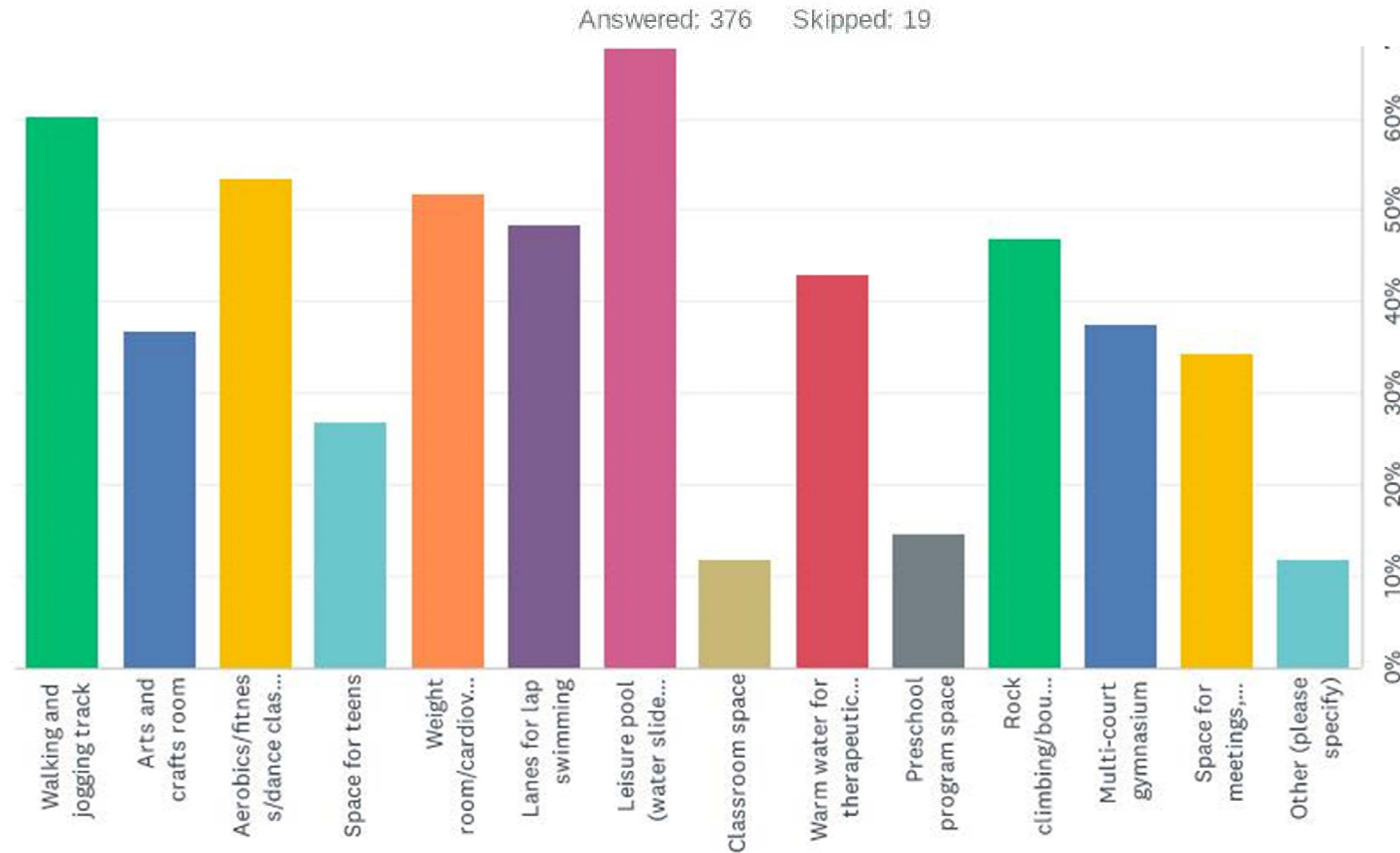


Q9 From the following listing of RAPRD facilities, please check ALL the RAPRD FACILITIES you and members of your household have used during the last 24 months.

Q16 If RAPRD were to develop new indoor programming spaces, please check from the following list ALL the potential indoor programming spaces you and members of your household would use.

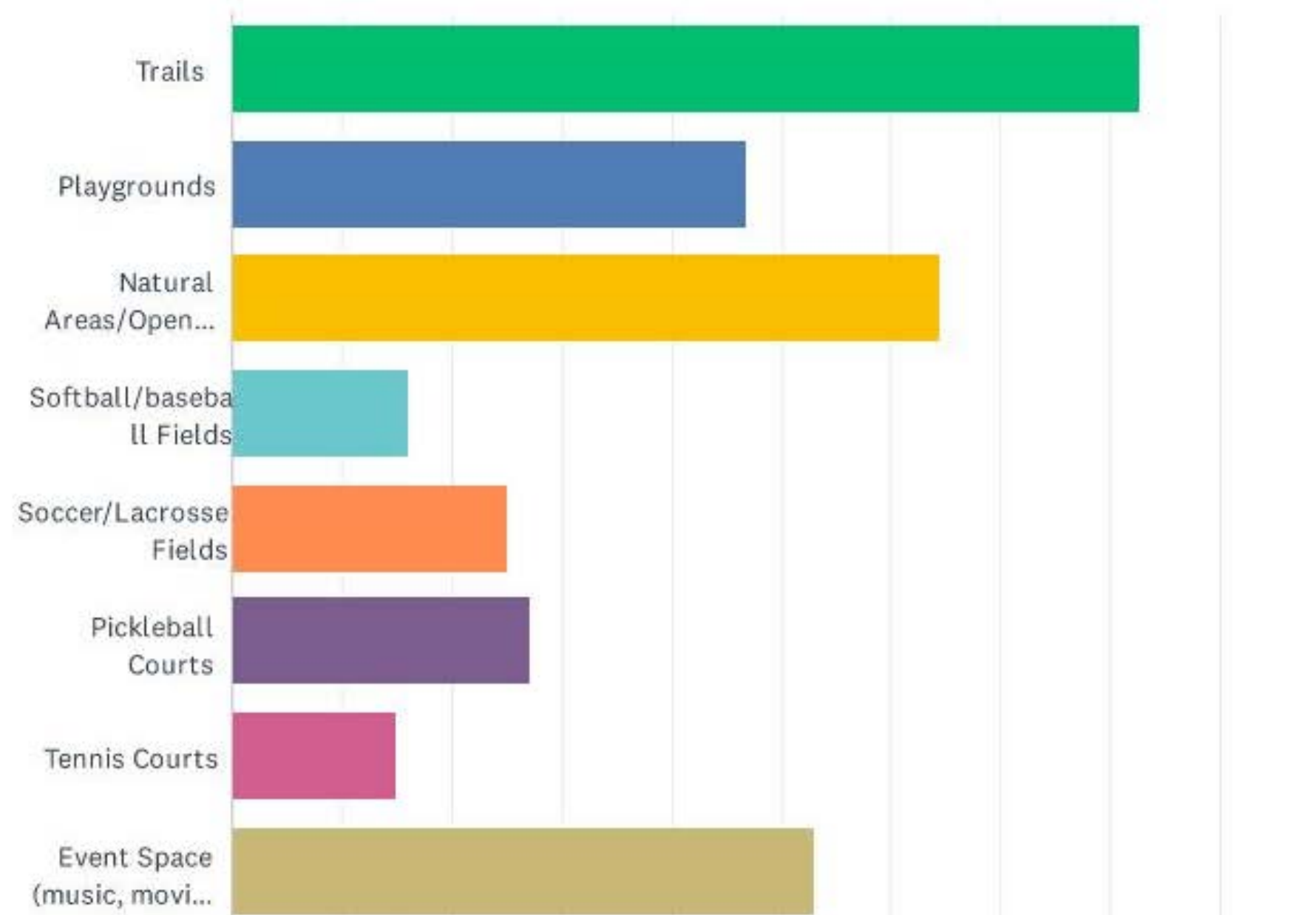
